REQUIRED TRIBE CODES: **[Three digit I.D. code 0 0 0]** for Urban Indians who are members of Federally-recognized Tribes, use the appropriate code for that Tribe in the I.H.S. Standard Code Book. For all other eligible Urban Indians, use the codes as explained below.

000 – Non-Indian (and Non-Federally Recognized)

- Use for any non-Indian client, i.e., anyone who is not an eligible Urban Indian, and services provided with funds from sources other than I.H.S.
- Use for any members and descendants of Canadian Tribes who are not otherwise eligible Urban Indians
- This field should not be used by UIO for services provided with I.H.S. funding, which can only be used to serve eligible Urban Indians; such services should be coded under the Specific Tribe's code or one of the codes below, not under this field

997 – Indian Non – Tribal Member

- Use for 1st or 2nd degree descendant of a member of a Federally-recognized Tribe
- Use for any self-identified Urban Indian until eligibility can be verified, then change to specific Tribe's code

999 – Indian Tribe Unspecified

- Use for any member, or 1st or 2nd degree descendant, of a Tribe recognized by the State where the Tribe is located
- Use for any member, or 1st or 2nd degree descendant, of any other tribe, band, or other organized group of Indians terminated since 1940

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This document is intended as a brief overview of documentation of tribal codes for consistent registration of eligible Urban Indians in RPMS and Non-RPMS systems by urban Indian organizations (UIO). Whether the UIO is using the I.H.S. RPMS software or commercial-off-the shelf software, it's recommended that all UIOs use the I.H.S. Standard Code Book Table for "Tribe," <https://www.ihs.gov/scb/>. The table can be downloaded for quick reference. This is necessary for consistency in the information received at the National Data Warehouse (NDW) for user population and workload.

The Ross Gritts Program will give you access to a Primary Care Practitioner and in-house labs, follow up visits and other IHC services until the funds run out. If there is a program which will cover your type of visit, we will request that you enroll in that special program first, e.g. please let us know if we need to update your demographics, we check for insurance enrollment dates at anytime. This is a payer of last resorts program for AI/AN's with no health insurance.

Services not included in the Ross Gritts Program are Counseling or Psychiatry and all outside services or referrals, medical supplies, prescriptions, and transportation.

This program is subject to change at any time.

- I understand that the Ross Gritts Program; is a first come first serve service, not an Insurance.
- This agreement expires: 06/30/2018.
- It gets reviewed yearly. Current renewal date: July 1st, 2017
- We will be checking your registration form, demographics and insurance status periodically.
- I understand that if I get insurance; I will be removed from the Ross Gritts program.
- I understand that if I no longer qualify, I will pay the Sliding Scale or full fee for all my visits, labs and procedures.
