## Indian Health Center of Santa Clara Valley Walk-in Immunization Clinic.-

- 1) Walk-in hours for Immunization and PPD testing are **Monday through Friday 8-11:00am & 1:00pm-3:30pm**. Upon availability of staff and/or extremely busy walk-in clinic, the IHC may close the vaccination clinic earlier without further notice.
- 2) During back to school season July and August, the walk-in clinic might experience delays from 15 minutes to 2 hours for vaccinations. **We do not schedule walk-in vaccinations in appointments.**
- 3) All children are required to bring in his/her Immunization records for review, the clinic will not administer specific vaccines asked by the schools without verification of up to date Immunizations appropriate for age.
- 4) If vaccination records are not available we will try to obtain records from CAIR, if child is not in CAIR and there are no other vaccine records, we will need to start the child in the whole series appropriate for age. Parents have the right to refuse any vaccines by signing a waiver at the clinic prior to the administration of the vaccine. If parent refuses to sign a waiver, the clinic has the right to deny vaccination services to the patient.
- 5) If vaccine records are in a different language other than English, the parent must get these records translated and notarized before bringing in a child for vaccinations.
- 6) If child is uninsured and qualifies for the VFC program, we will only charge a vaccination administration fee that varies depending on the number of vaccine he/she gets. Eligibility for the VFC program is done in person at the clinic. **No eligibility is done over the phone.** The VFC program can only be used in children through their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday.
- 7) All children must be accompanied by a parent. If the person accompanying the child for vaccinations is not the parent he/she will have to present proof of legal guardianship and provide a valid ID.
- 8) If a child has private insurance and has a Primary Care Physician in a different location, we encourage these children to receive their vaccines with their PCP's.
- 9) If a child tests positive for a PPD test, we will need to refer the child for a CXR and have child be seen by one of our Providers before clearing the child for school. These services will have an additional cost and wait time.
- 10) If you need transcription of records or any prior vaccination records we require a minimum of 24 hours for completion depending on the season.
